

For Graduate Students

RESEARCH

- Schedule an appointment with your librarian for a research consultation
- Reserve a locker, carrel, or spot in the Graduate Research Commons
- Use the Graduate Reading Room in Perkins Library (Ask for the code at the Perkins Service Desk; available only to grad students)
- Get expert help with data management and visualization
- Get help with citation management tools
- Recommend books and other materials for the library to purchase

PUBLICATION

- Consult the Office of Copyright and Scholarly Communication at the Libraries about copyright, fair use and open access policy
- Ask your librarian for help with locating high impact journals to publish

TEACHING

- Place supplemental course materials on Reserve
- Schedule a library instruction for your class

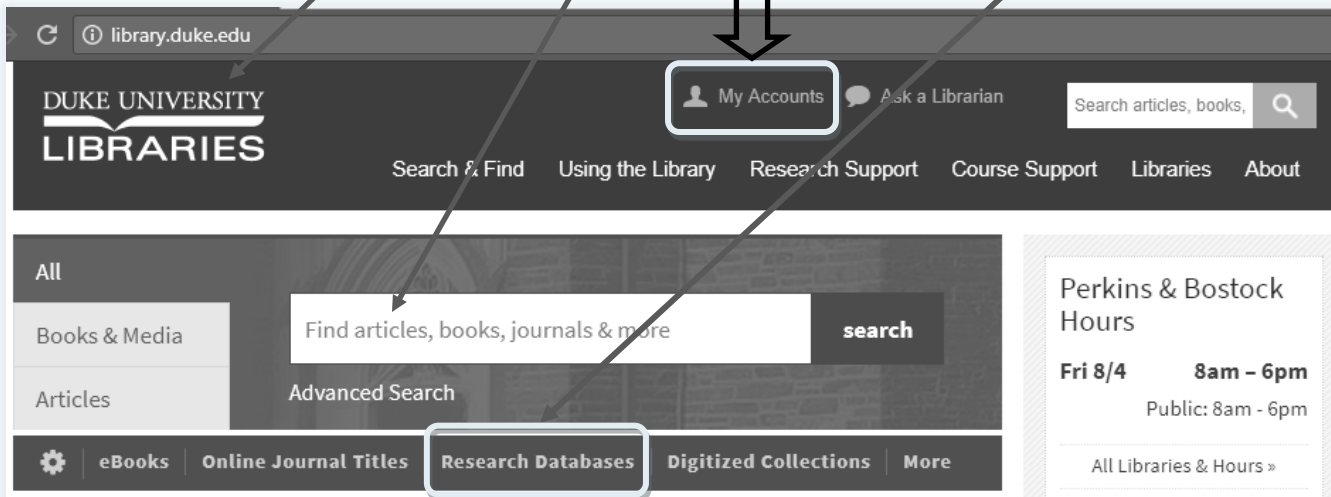

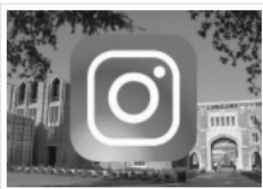
